What are the advantages of a rain barrel? Lawn and garden watering make up nearly 40% of total household water use during the summer. A rain barrel collects water and stores it for when you need it most – during periods of drought or during peak usage. It provides an ample supply of free “soft water” to homeowners, containing no chlorine, lime or calcium making it ideal for gardens, indoor plants, and car and window washing. A rain barrel will save most homeowners about 1,300 gallons of water during the peak summer months. Saving water not only helps protect the environment, it decreases the demand for treated tap water. Diverting water from storm drains also decreases the impact of runoff to streams. The IMPACT of this Rain Barrel Program grows as more community members and communities add Rain Barrels to their homes! Also, the buyer is saving \$15 when buying through the Conservation District.

- 💧 55-gallon recycled food grade barrel
- 💧 Removable intake screen to keep debris and mosquitoes out
- 💧 Overflow directs water away from the foundation.
- 💧 Connects to drip irrigation, soaker and garden hoses
- 💧 Color prevents light transmission & inhibits algae growth
- 💧 Easy to set up and use; Screw off top for easy cleaning
- 💧 Saves rainwater and replenishes our groundwater
- 💧 Reduces runoff that adds to stormwater problems
